# St. Bart's Organic Produce Garden Project:

Plant, Grow, Harvest & Share

**PROGRESS TO DATE:** There are now six beds built on the strip running by the kitchen. Monday morning, Dixie levelled four of them with Niko's help and Penny lined them with cardboard, garden cloth and free tarps from GBS. Did you know GBS has a tarp bin that people can help themselves to for free? Dixie is due to prep the last two and Penny will line them also. Thank you to Harvey for his help as well!

In the meantime, the soil Helen ordered arrived from Salish Soils and is also covered with a free tarp in case it rains before Thursday, when we'll fill the beds.

The bear poop found behind the shed is NOT fertilizer—it's a reminder that our bear will be monitoring the garden beds along with the rest of us. As Helen says, "he'll go wherever we put the beds." We just have to expect that we might lose a bit of produce. However, this is our first go at our own garden so we'll assess any damage in the fall, and plan the next year accordingly.

Next on the list: an animal barrier around the beds, of course! *Want to help?!*
